SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

Program of study with emphasis on COP and I3

The Situational Awareness program of study at the Joint Deployment Training Center (JDTC) provides the joint operations community with functional Training and Education (T&E) support on DoD's C2 system of record, Global Command and Control System-Joint (GCCS-J). T&E on these situational awareness applications provide DoD decision makers the ability to keep "virtual" eyes-on worldwide friendly and enemy operations, assets, and intelligence.

GCCS-J Common Operational Picture (COP) and Integrated Imagery and Intelligence (I3) provide DoD decision makers with an accurate, near real-time representation of information within their operational environments. Users can tailor their display to meet specific operational, intelligence, and support requirements at each echelon of command, giving them operational advantage over the adversary.
